

Analysis of Survey Results "Teacher Through the Eyes of Students" (1st Semester 2024-2025)

General Information:

- Target Audience: 10027 students.
- Surveyed: 7182 (72% of the target audience).
- Period: 12.12.2024 - 10.01.2025.
- Number of results found: 488

General Conclusions:

The survey results demonstrate a high evaluation of teachers by students across all presented criteria. Average scores for all questions are in the range of 8.6 - 8.7, indicating a positive perception of teaching activities.

Detailed Analysis by Criteria:

All criteria received practically the same high scores, which indicates a balanced approach of teachers to the educational process. However, several aspects requiring special attention can be highlighted:

- **Highest Scores (8.7 points):**
 - Ability to evoke and maintain interest in the subject
 - Knowledge of the subject, mastery of the teaching material
 - Accessibility of presentation of the teaching material
 - Culture of speech, pace of presentation of the teaching material
 - Interaction with students during classes
 - Use of modern information teaching tools
 - Demandingness of knowledge and skills of students
 - Objectivity in assessing knowledge
- **Slightly Lower Scores (8.6 points):**
 - Use of interactive teaching technology methods
 - Goodwill and correctness towards students

Recommendations:

Despite the high overall results, there are always opportunities for improvement. Based on the analysis, the following recommendations can be suggested:

- **Interactive Teaching Methods:**
 - It is recommended to pay attention to the more active introduction of interactive teaching methods into the educational process, such as role-playing games, discussions, debates, brainstorming, and analysis of specific situations. This will increase student engagement and make learning more interesting and effective.
 - Organize seminars and trainings for teachers on the use of interactive methods.
- **Goodwill and Correctness:**
 - Support and develop a benevolent and correct attitude towards students.
 - Conduct training sessions on the development of communication skills and ethics of communication for teachers.

Conclusion:

In general, the survey results indicate a high level of professionalism of teachers and their effective interaction with students. The proposed recommendations are aimed at further improving the educational process and increasing student satisfaction.
